



Situate in Buffalo township Union (late Berks) County. Surveyed the 8th day of October 1832. by virtue of an Order granted to Phillip Erb, bearing date the 3^d day of April 1769. N^o 615. Containing two hundred and forty one Acres and five tenths with the Usual Allowance of Six per Cent &c.

Note-The same tract of land was surveyed the 10th day of June 1771. for Hannah Rees in pursuance of her Order dated the 3^d day of April 1769. N^o 658. And now owned and occupied by John Strohecker in right of the said Hannah Rees.
