I return the above tract which was originally survey'd by Charles Lukens Esq^r about the ^{year} 1770 for Grace Little in pursuance of her application N^o 196 dated the 3^d day of Ap^r 1769. Situate in Nipenose township Lycoming County containing two hundred and ninety five acres seven perches & allowance of 6 pr. Ct. Ret^d by me the 2^d Oct^r 1828.
