



Situate in Buffalo township Union (late Berks) County. Surveyed the 10th day of May 1833 by virtue of an Order granted to John Hoge sr dated the 3^d day of April 1769 N^o 254. Containing three hundred and ten Acres with the Usual Allowance &c.

Note. The same being part of a tract of land containing 703 Acres which was surveyed the 3^d day of March 1769 for the Rev^d John Ewing in pursuance of his Order of Survey dated the 7th day of February 1769 N^o 12. And now owned & occupied by Michael Wolf and others - In right of the said John Ewing.
