



Situate in Buffalo township Union (late Berks) County. Surveyed the 6th day of November 1832. by virtue of an Order granted to Phillip Pfeffer dated the 3^d day of April 1769 N^o 653. Containing three hundred & twenty Acres with the Usual Allowance &c.

Note. The same tract of land was Surveyed the 25th day of February 1769 for Cap^t William Plunket (being included in a tract of 619.7 Acres) being the Allotment which fell to him on the Division of 8000 Acres Surveyed for the Officers of Col^o Turbul Francis Corps. in pursuance of an Order of Survey N^o 1. And now Owned and Occupied by Martin Drisbach in right of the said Cap^t William Plunket.
