



Situate in Kelly township Union (late Berks) County. Surveyed the 3^d day of August 1832 by Virtue of an Order granted to William Harwickle dated the 3^d day of April 1769. N. 740 Containing three hundred & three Acres & one hundred & fifty eight perches with the usual Allowance &c.

Note. The Same tract of land was Surveyed the 19th day of October 1769. (by Charles Lukens) for Jacob Weyland in pursuance of his Order dated the 3^d day of April 1769. N. 6. And now owned and occupied by George Royer & others. in right of the said Jacob Wyland.
