N<sup>o</sup> 773. granted to John Downey Containing three hundred & one Acres & 70 perches with the allowance &c.

N<sup>o</sup> 2657. and is now owned and Occupied by Peter Mangas, Sam! Shade & others in right of Said James Baskin.
