 William M^cGriff shew the date of the Original Surv. Adam Derdt (alias Der) lived on
 Jacob Krebs Esq the land before the last Indian War and was driven from it by
 Henry Steger Esq them. after the Revolutionary war he took out another Warrant in
 George Bodey & his name dated the 8th of November A.D. 1785 and which was
 Hellebush Surveyed and Returned and Patented this last Warrant & Surv had
 Who reside on it or did include the little tract adjoining the above Surv. included in Red lines
