



Application 4366, 9<sup>th</sup> Sept<sup>r</sup>, 1767, to Samuel Redman for 50<sup>ac</sup> in Hamiltonburg Town P<sup>e</sup> on the waters of Tom's Creek near the Green Ridge in the South Mountain.

The whole of the above Tract is an Interference of a Tract of 93<sup>ac</sup> 79<sup>ps</sup> & all<sup>cs</sup> surveyed on warrant to Samuel & Joseph Scott in right of William Parkin, dated 18<sup>th</sup> October, 1754, situate now in Liberty Township, Adams County, now owned by Henry Wirt, occupied by Lewis Wirt.
