Surveyed the 4th day of August 1833 by virtue of an Order ^{or Warrant} granted to Levi Hollingsworth dated the 14th day of February 1771 containing two hundred & fifteen Acres with the usual allowance &c.
 Note. The same tract of land was surveyed for John Cook and John Reed respectively on their several Warrants. And after a tedious Lawsuit John Cook gained. And now owned and Occupied by John Hummel in right of John Cook.
