



By virtue of a Warrant, dated November 2<sup>d</sup> 1749, granted to George Ongstead, there was surveyed on the 13<sup>th</sup> day of February 1753, the above described tract of land, situate among the Oley Hills in Berks County, Containing Twelve acres, eighty nine perches and allowance of 6 P.Ct.
