of the State of Pennsylvania passed the 24 day of February 1785
entitled "An act for directing the mode of distributing the donation
lands promised to the troops of this Commonwealth." And by order
of the Surveyor General with the approbation of the Hon^{ble} Executive
Council, I have surveyed on the 29th day of August 1785 the above
described tract of two hundred acres & allowance of six P.C.
for Roads &c. Nº M.M.C.&L. situate in district Nº 10 on the West
side of Alleghany River in the County of Westmoreland.
