The lines of the above Survey were made in 1755 as appears by the
 Actual Survey line trees on the ground. The Improvements on the above land was
 Present Owners commenced as is said about the date of the Warrant but afterwards
 Heirs of George Ege Esq. about the year 1784 or 5 abandoned and left on account of the
 Ind. who occupy the Sam Indian War. It consist now of a house stable Garden cleared land
 & meadow. No Draught to shew the date of the Original Survey in
 G. Gardner Pat 1798 or 99 or thereabouts. a warrant was laid on the above tract in the
 name of George Gardner dated the 13 March 1752 by which it is now held.
