


FORM NO 1.



Rockland township, Berks County. Originally Surveyed to George Ulrich Fisher, on Warrant dated the 7<sup>th</sup> day of March 1733. Containing A<sup>s</sup> 156. 66 P<sup>s</sup> & all<sup>s</sup> and on which a certain Jacob Smith paid on the 9<sup>th</sup> day of August 1794, to the late Proprietaries the sum of fifteen pounds and four shilling in part of the purchase money for his Warrant of same date, for the above described tract of land.
