



In pursuance of the several Acts of Assembly directing the recovery of the Principal and interest due to the Commonwealth from persons holding Lands by Virtue of Locations or other Office Titles issued from or under the Proprietary Government and for other purposes, I have this day located and surveyed Application No 4392, issued 19th Sept. 1767, to Robert Hill for 150 acres in Reading Township, on Lands situate in Reading Township, joining Robert Hill's other Land & others, and have found the Interferences as represented in the enclosed Diagram.
