--- this line shewes a Survey made also at a subsequent time on a Warrant to Michael Ohi dated the AD. 17. under which Warrant the present owner now holds but both these Warrants are not returned. the above two yellow surveys will be abandoned by the present owner who hold now the said office rights all together.
