



Pursuant to the instructions of the Board of Property of the State of Penn^a dated Nov^r. 1st 1821 I attended to the duties therein stated & report the following notes &c. as the result of the investigations had upon the premises &c.

Note the above Tract of Land as represented by the Draft Survey &c upon Geo. Isherwoods warrant of the 12th of Feb^r. 1773. Contains one hundred acres & all. The Survey of Peter Helman in right of Wm Waddil on Warrt of the 30th August 1785 makes an Interference at A. with Isherwoods survey. The angle at B. interferes with Jn. M. Masters in right of Jn. Reed upon Warrt. The Ballance of the Tract interferes with a survey of Sam'l Jones in right of Jn. Walker upon Warrt. The two last mentioned surveys are patented. Situate in Versailles Township Allegy County.
