Isherwoods Warrt of the 12<sup>th</sup> of Feb<sup>y</sup> 1773 and is all Included within the Survey of Peter Helman in right of William Waddle on Warrt of the 30<sup>th</sup> of August 1785 with the Exception of a small angle convenient to A. Situate in Versailles Township Allegheny County.
