In pursuance of a contract with the Board of Property for carrying into effect the several Acts of Assembly relating to unpatented lands under proprietary rights &c. By virtue of a warrant dated 16th August 1754, granted to Robert & Henry Mahan for 100 A^c including improvement purchased of Andrew O'Neal, joining Malcom McComb, in Lurgan township. N.B. first survey^d on the above warrant the 6 February 1770.
