



Application 4878- 25<sup>th</sup> March 1768 granted to John Barton for 75 acres in Mannheim township.

In pursuance of the several Acts of Assembly directing the recovery of the principal and interest due to the Commonwealth from persons holding lands by virtue of locations or other office titles issued from or under the Proprietary Government and for other purposes, I have this day located and surveyed application 4878- 25<sup>th</sup> March 1768 granted to John Barton for 75 acres of land in Mannheim township, on lands situate in Mannheim township aforesaid, and have found the interferences as represented in the enclosed diagram. Witness my hand.
