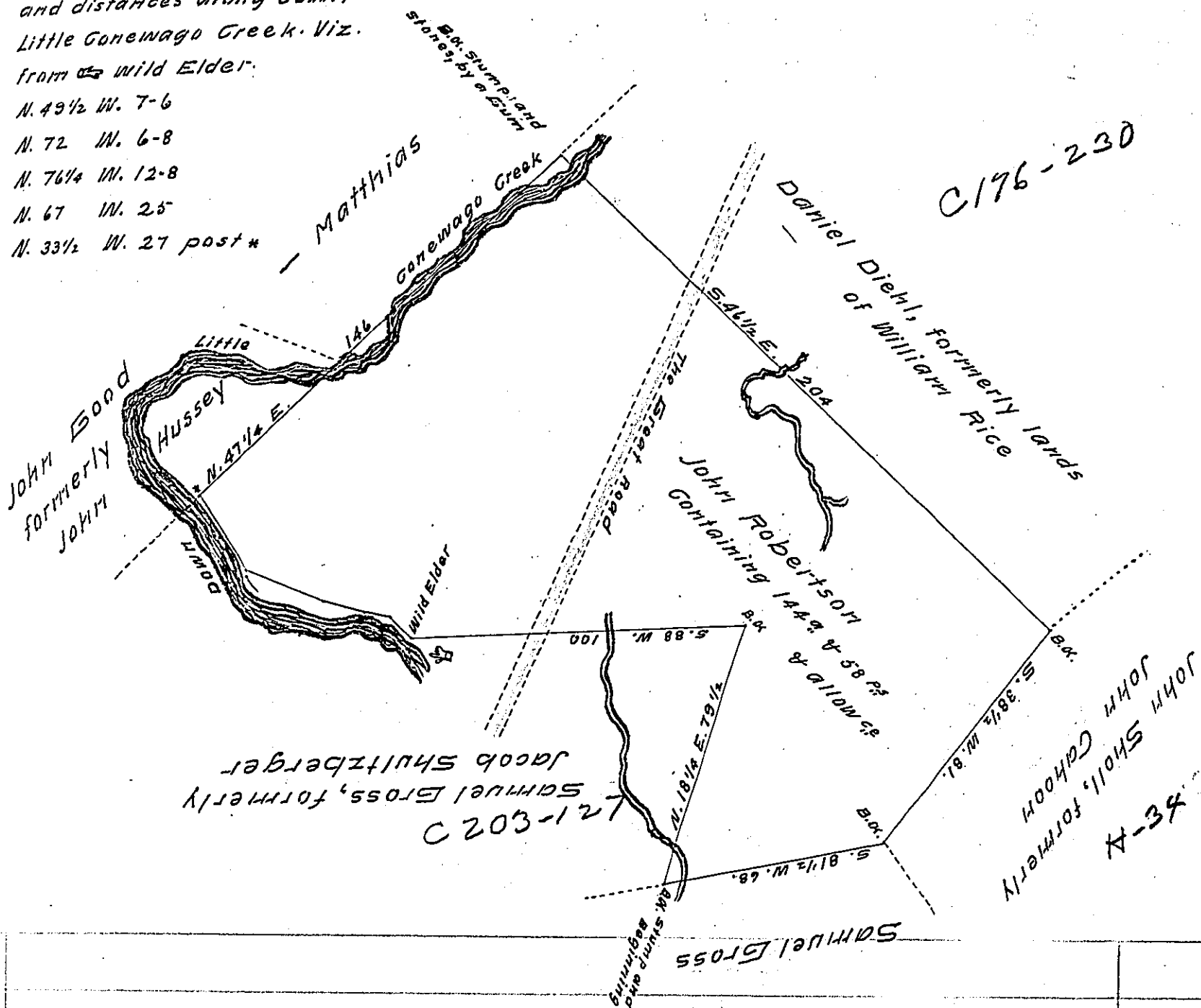


The following are the courses and distances along down Little Conewago Creek. Viz. from ~~to~~ Wild Elder:
