



Situate near the State road at the foot of Sidney's Nob in Dublin township Bedford County, containing one hundred and thirty six acres and one hundred and ten perch and allowance, surveyed in December 1788 on order No 4829, dated 11th day of March 1768 granted to William Harvey, Jr.
