Report.

The above described survey embraces or covers two entire tracts of land; one whereof represented by the figure marked A. surveyed 15 December 1785 on warrant to Matthew Wilson dated first Sept^r 1785 containing 101 A^s 100^{ps} & all. The other tract represented by the figure marked B. of 105^a 17^{ps} surveyed 9 Dec^r 1807 on warrant to George Werner dated 16 Nov^r 1807, both these tracts confirmed by patent. Note - The above land called Charles Magills claim by Robt Gummings survey above mentioned.

N.B. The above tract A. owned & occupied by Jacob Zent, under patent on Wilsons warrant, and the tract B. owned & occupied by Archibald Babby & Sam^l Cooper under patent on Werners warrant
