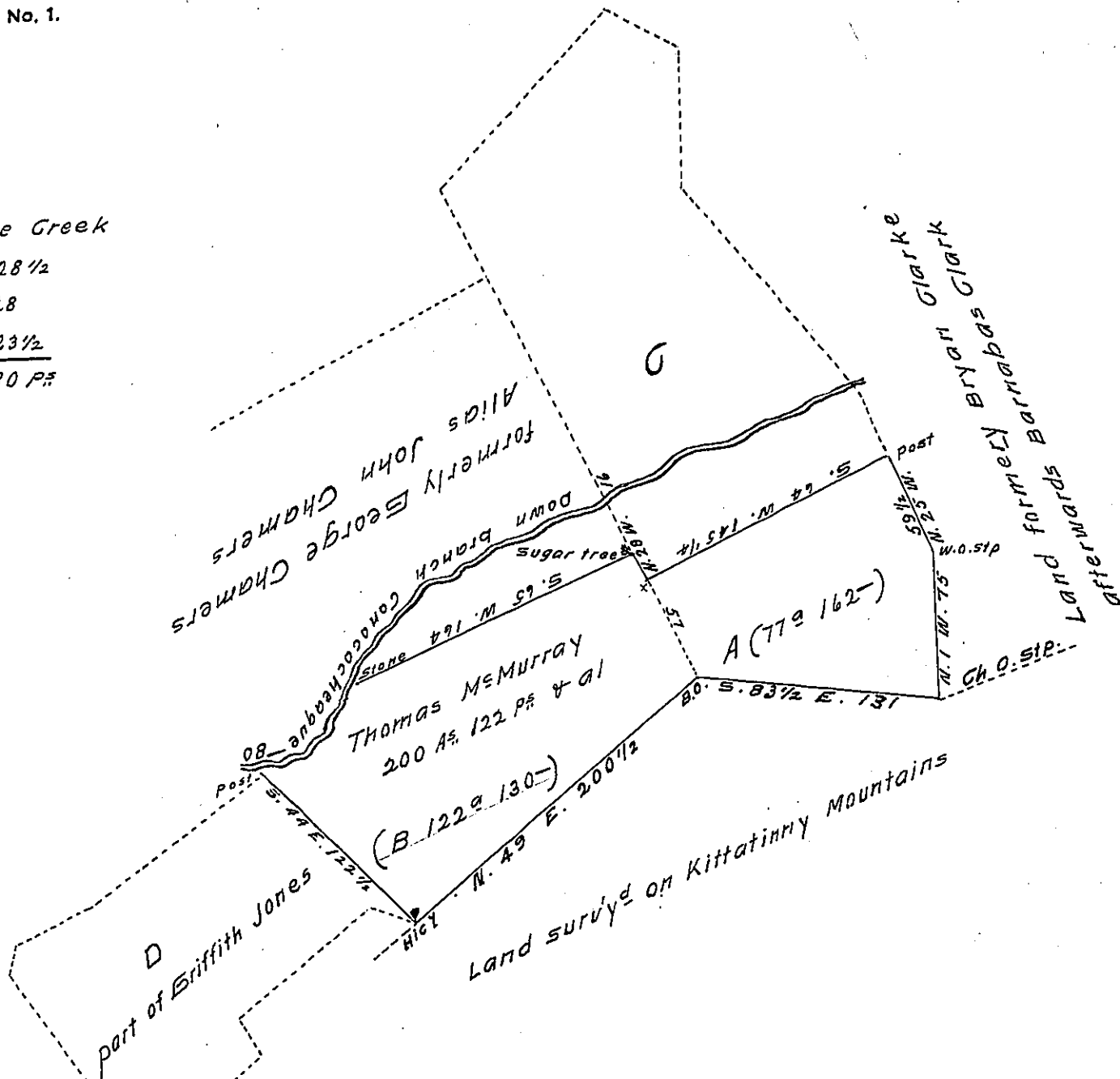

Report

The above tract is covered by the following office rights to wit. The part marked A. of 77 acres 162 perches & al. is included in a survey of 270 A^s 148 P^s on an order of survey to Stephen Duncan dated 13th Dec^r 1766 No 2168 & held under said title. The dotted figure G represents the balance of survey on Duncan's order.

The part of the tract marked B. is included within the lines of a larger tract of 244 acres survey'd on a warrant to Griffith Jones dated 14th December 1785 and held under said title.

Note. The part A owned & occupied by Peter Stake, and the part B owned and occupied by W^m Emery's heirs and James Kilgore.

N.B. No evidence of possession in Mc Murray or any person claiming under his location.
