



Application 4613, 25th November 1767, to Robert Skeem for 300 a^s in Huntingdon township-

In pursuance of the several Acts of Assembly directing the recovery of the principal and interest due to the Commonwealth from persons holding lands by virtue of locations or other office titles issued from or under the Proprietary Government and for other purposes. I have this day located and surveyed App^d 4613, 25th Novem^r 1767, to Robert Skeem for 300 a^s as above specified in James Moorhead Huntingdon T. on lands situate as aforesaid in Huntingdon township & have found the interferences as represented in the enclosed diagram.
