In pursuance of the several Acts of Assembly directing the recovery of the principal and interest due to the Commonwealth from persons holding lands by virtue of locations or other office titles issued from or under the Proprietary Government and for other purposes, I have this day located & surveyed app<sup>n</sup> No 4685 granted 8<sup>th</sup> January 1768 to Alexander Tanderson for 30<sup>ac</sup> joining James Bracken & his other land in Huntingdon township on lands situate as aforesaid, & have found the interferences as represented in the enclosed diagram.
