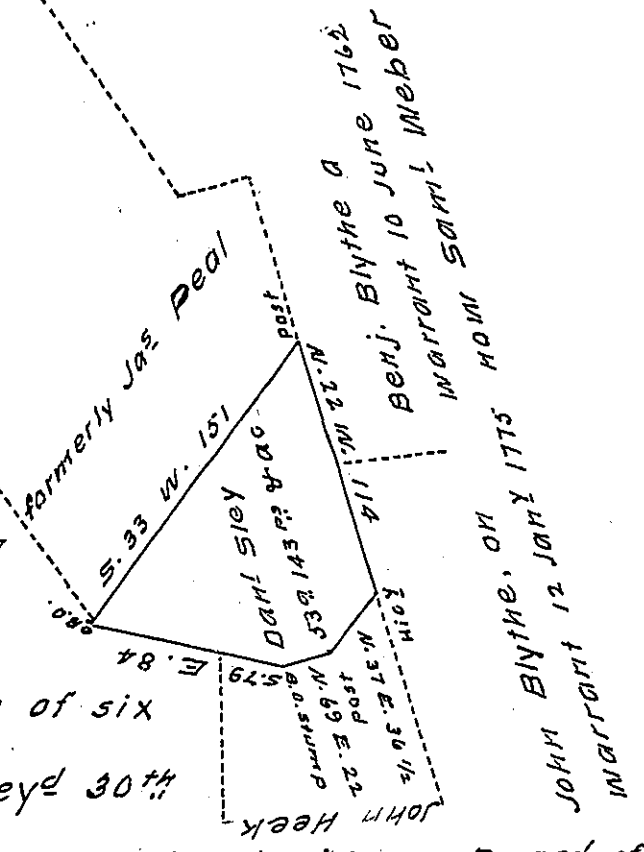


Draught of a tract of land

 "joining" Benjamin Blythe, and James Peal, in Lurgan township, Re-  
 surveyed agreeable to lines formerly surveyed on this warrant

 warrant granted to Benjamin Blythe, Jun<sup>r</sup> for 400 A<sup>s</sup> dated 2<sup>d</sup> Dec<sup>r</sup>
