



Situate in West Buffalo township Union (late Berks) county survey-  
ed the 17<sup>th</sup> day of September 1833 by virtue of a warrant grant-  
ed to Samuel Reyer, dated the 15<sup>th</sup> October 1732 containing one  
hundred acres with the usual allowance.

Note. The same tract of land is part of a tract of ~~of~~ land  
containing \_\_\_\_\_ acres granted to John Harris, by warrant dated  
the 7<sup>th</sup> day of February 1755, and surveyed the 23<sup>d</sup> day of Feb-  
ruary 1769, and now owned and occupied by ~~Sam~~ Robert Bar-  
ber, Esq. in right of the said John Harris.
