



Draft of a tract of land situate now in Montgomery township (formerly Peters township) Franklin county containing twenty five acres one hundred (seven perches & allowance of six per cent for roads &c) & located the 24<sup>th</sup> of January 1829 (on a warrant granted William Shannon for 25<sup>a</sup> 95 of land joining his other land & James Black in Peters township dated the 24<sup>th</sup> of May 1753) by virtue of a contract with the Board of Property for carrying into effect the several Acts of Assembly relating to proprietary rights &c.

Note. The land above described is included in a survey containing 63<sup>a</sup> 19 per & all which was surveyed in pursuance of a warrant granted David Shannon dated the 13<sup>th</sup> of Dec<sup>r</sup> 1787, there is no evidence of any survey having been made on the warrant to William Shannon; but the heirs ~~having~~ of William Shannon, having held the above land before the warrant of David Shannon, was granted there is no doubt but that it was intended to be laid on this land.
