



A draft of a tract of land situate in the forks of Licking—in the Great Cove in Air township, Bedford County containing one hundred & fifty two acres ^{100 perches} & allowance of six per cent for roads & so, surveyed for Patrick Maxwell in pursuance of a warrant dated the 8th day of June 1762.

The Green lines represent the draft of a tract of land surveyed for Bigger Head in pursuance of a warrant dated the 4th day of September 1786. This tract interferes one hundred & fifty two acres & one hundred perches with the Patrick Maxwell tract—Patrick Maxwell conveyed to Bigger Head who obtained the aforesaid warrant and then conveyed the same to Peter Whitmore who conveyed the same to Jacob Whitmore who conveyed part of this tract to John Shriver who conveyed the same to Abraham Hershey who devised the same to his heirs the present owners Jacob Whitmore conveyed one other parcel of this tract to Michael Bare who devised the same to his heirs who are the present owners, the residue of this tract was sold from Jacob Whitmore by the Sheriff of Bedford County to David Fore the present owner.
