



Situate in Hartleton township Union (late Berks.) County  
Surveyed the \_\_\_\_\_ day of September 1833 by virtue of a  
warrant granted to John Tyre, dated the 27<sup>th</sup> day of Feb-  
ruary 1755 containing one hundred acres with the usual  
allowance of six pr. ct &c.

The same being part of a tract of 307.79<sup>rs</sup> of land survey-  
ed the 18<sup>th</sup> day of June 1771 for John Harris, in pursuance of  
his order of survey dated the 4<sup>th</sup> day of April 1769 No 2783  
and now owned & occupied by the heirs of John Williams,  
dead in right of the said John Harris.
