



Draft of a tract of land situate now in Washington township Franklin County containing thirty eight acres forty perches and allowance of six per cent for roads &c. which was surveyed the 28th day of September 1789 by Matthew Henderson, Esq. then Deputy surveyor in pursuance of a warrant granted John Burns for 25 a. dated the 17th day of February 1775 a rough draft of which remains on file in the Deputy Surveyors office of Franklin County. Certified the 21st day of January 1830 in pursuance of a contract with the Board of property for carrying into effect the several Acts of Assembly relating to proprietary rights &c.
