



A draft of a tract of land situate on Shawneese Cabbim Creek in Mapiertownship Bedford County containing two hundred & eighty one acres & allowance of six percent for roads surveyed for David Magaw in pursuance of a warrant dated the 13<sup>th</sup> day of August 1766. No 1 represented by the dotted — is a draft of a tract of land surveyed for John Pollock the 22<sup>nd</sup> day of January 1800, in pursuance of order No 1257 dated the 15<sup>th</sup> day of September 1766. This tract interferes sixty one acres & one hundred & sixty one perches with the David Magaw tract, John Pollock conveyed to John Manrey, who conveyed to Jacob Hillegass the present owner.
