



Situate in West Buffalo township Union (late Berks) county surveyed the 20th day of August 1832 by virtue of a warrant granted to John Broght dated the 10th day of February 1755 containing one hundred acres with the usual allowance of six per cent &c.

Note - The same tract of land is included in a tract of land granted to John Harris by warrant dated the 17th day of February 1755 and surveyed the 23d day of February 1769, and now owned & occupied by Samuel B. Heis, in right of the said John Harris.
