



A draft of a tract of land situate on the east side of Dunning's Creek and on the waters thereof in the township & county of Bedford surveyed the 14<sup>th</sup> day of June 1765 for Francis Campbell, on warrant dated the 5<sup>th</sup> day of July 1762 - C.

N.B. The green lines represent the drafts of a tract of land surveyed for Valentine Shadacre on order No 848 dated the 12<sup>th</sup> day of August 1766, this tract interferes two hundred and forty three acres and twenty nine perches with the Francis Campbell tract. Valentine Shadacre, conveyed to David Rhinehart, he to Michael Dibert, who conveyed to Frederick Dibert, the present owner.
