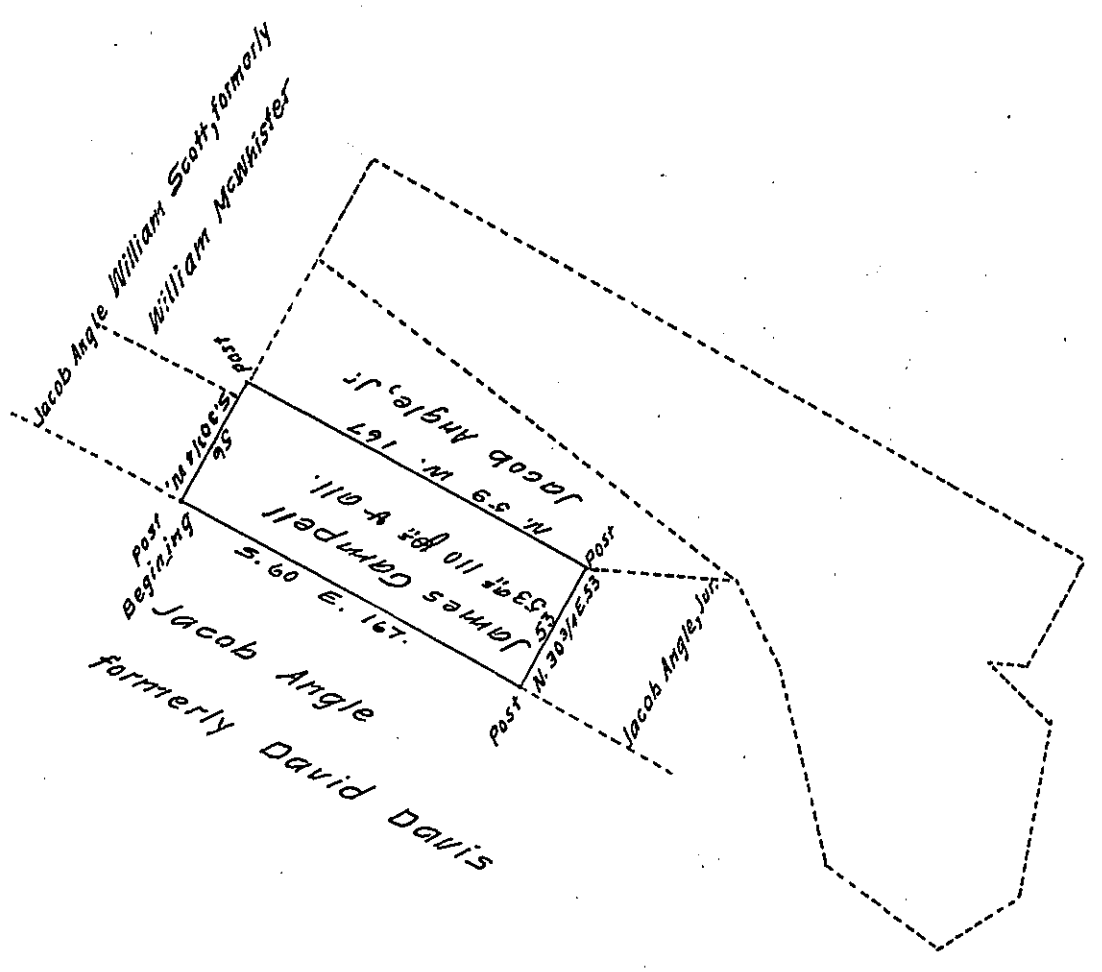


FORM NO 1.



Draft of a tract of land situate in Montgomery township (formerly Peters township) Franklin County containing fifty three acres one hundred & ten perches & allowance of six per cent for roads &c. Surveyed the 28<sup>th</sup> of October 1828 in pursuance of a contract with the Board of property for carrying into effect the several Acts of Assembly relating to proprietary rights & on a warrant granted James Campbell, dated the 20<sup>th</sup> of February 1754 including his improvement joining David Davis, in Peters township.

The land above described is included in a survey containing 918<sup>ac</sup> 64<sup>per</sup> & all which was surveyed on a warrant granted John Shelby dated the 29<sup>th</sup> of October 1772 under which the present owners claim no evidence obtained of any survey having been made on Campbell's warrant but the land was recognized as Campbell's land shortly after the date of his warrant.
