

Report-The above tract is covered and held under a warrant to Anthony Maul, for 100 acres dated 10<sup>th</sup> October 1786, which land was surveyed 20<sup>th</sup> February 1799. In dispute between Anthony Maul & Hugh Campbell, on their respective warrants above stated; the warrant of Maul at that time & ever since appears to have prevailed as being much more descriptive of the land including the improvement.
