



Draft of a tract of land situate in Washington township (formerly Antrim township) Franklin County containing seven acres one hundred & fifty nine perches & allowance of six per cent for roads &c which was surveyed on a warrant granted John Caldwell, for 100 ac of land join^g land of John Scott & Casper Wiggoner in Antrim township dated the 5th of Feb^y 1770 as appears from a rough draft now in the Deputy Surveyor's office of Franklin County certified the 11th day of March 1830 in pursuance of a contract with the Board of Property for carrying into effect the several Acts of Assembly relating to proprietary rights &c.
