 &c which was surveyed the 28th day of September 1789 by Matthew
 Henderson, Esq; their Deputy Surveyor in pursuance of a warrant
 granted George Martin for 100 a.s. dated the 6th day of Sept^r 1762
 a rough draft of which remains on file in the Deputy Survey-
 ors office of Franklin County. Certified the 21st day of
 January 1830. In pursuance of a contract with the Board
 of property for carrying into effect the several Acts of
 Assembly relating to proprietary rights &c.
