



The above tracts A and B are interferences of a tract surveyed on warrant to James Agnew, for 200 a^s dated Jan^y 9th 1786 by Archibald McClean, D.S. resurveyed June 20th 1811 and Leatherman's warrant laid on A & B. Part B was not included in McClean's survey, situate in Hamiltonbann township Adams County and Agnew's tract now owned by Robert Douglass;
