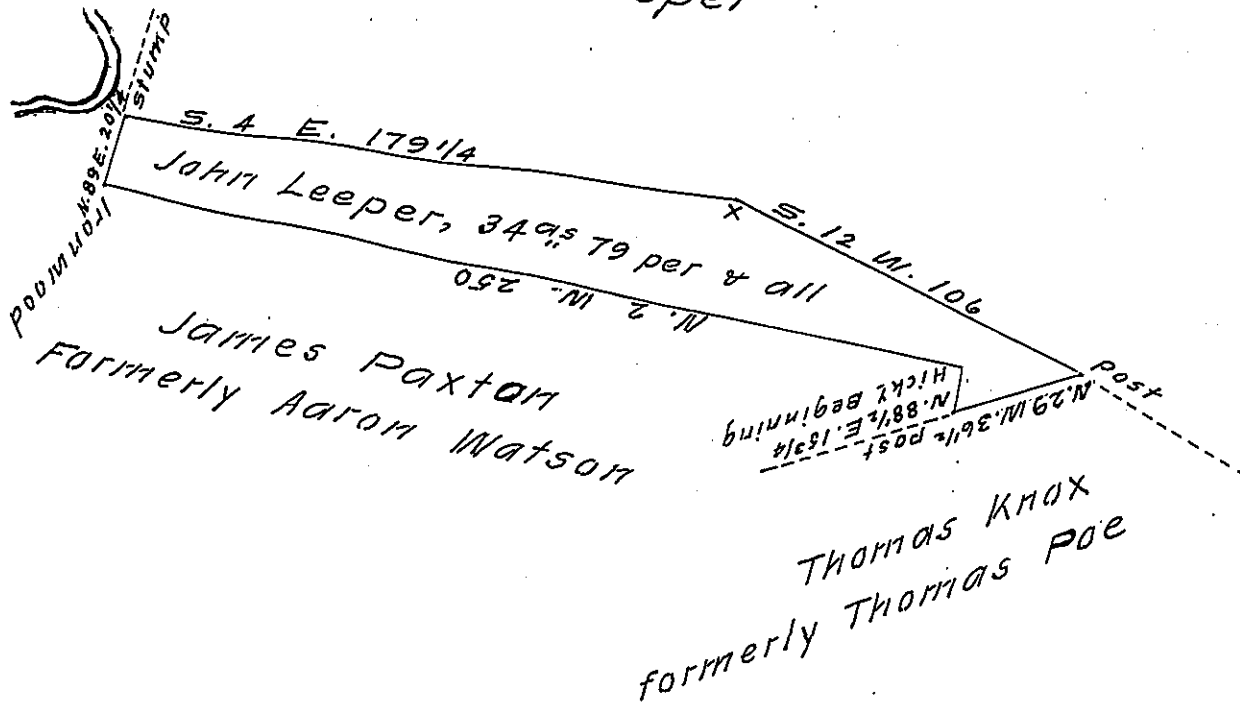


Robert Leeper



Draft of a tract of land situate in St. Thomas township (formerly Hamilton township) Franklin County containing thirty four acres seventy nine perches & allowance of six per cent for roads &c. located the 19th of April 1830 (on a warrant granted John Leeper, for 40^{ac} of land joining Tho^s Poe & Aaron Watson, in Hamilton township dated the 15th of May 1754) in pursuance of a contract with the Board of property for carrying into effect the several Acts of Assembly relating to proprietary rights &c.
