 on a warrant to Archibald Mahan dated 29 August 1785.
 Note - Although the warrant of 1754 calls for 100 acres yet the re-
 lative situation of the boundaries & improvement would would
 necessarily include more land, the blank dotted figure represents
 the balance of survey on the warrant of 1785. Owners, John, David & George
