The lines of the Red Survey were made on Robert  
 Stephens Appl<sup>ca</sup> N<sup>o</sup> 1320. and the yellow Sury was made  
 on Richard Stephens W<sup>t</sup> dated the 21, Oct. 1751. in the year  
 1780 as the line trees shew. there is no Draught shew-  
 ing the dates of Sury of the two Surys nor of the Blue  
 Sury. — the Blue Sury was made on a W<sup>t</sup> to George  
 Custard. dated between 1750 & 1760. — cannot find out  
 the date. the impr<sup>t</sup> on the Red & yellow Surys is  
 only some cleared land — the impr<sup>t</sup> on the Blue  
 Sury was commenced about 37 years ago. —
