



Warrant dated 15<sup>th</sup> June 1773 to John Graybill for 10<sup>ac</sup> Join<sup>g</sup> his other Land, John Abbott & Lawrence Peckinger in Berwick Towne

In pursuance of the several Acts of Assembly directing the recovery of the Principal and Interest due to the Commonwealth from Persons holding Lands by Virtue of Locations or other Office Titles issued from or under the Proprietary Government & for other Purposes, I have this day located and surveyed Warrant granted 15<sup>th</sup> June 1773 — to John Graybill for 10<sup>ac</sup> as above specified in Berwick Township, on Lands situate as aforesaid in Berwick Township, and have found the Interferences as represented in the enclosed Diagram —
