Situate in Peach Bottom late Fawn township in the county of York Containing as above set forth within the black lines 43^{as} 19^{ps} & the usual allowance &c. Located on the 16 day of June 1831 in pursuance of a warrant granted to Robert Gordon for 40^{as} dated the 26 day of July 1770 and by Virtue of the contract entered into with the Board of Property. Report the above Land was disputed before the Board of Property but I am not able to give the grounds of Dispute See entry of the Trial Jns. Lang vs. Thomas Cooper and Walter Robison the 31 of December 1770. It is altogether in the State of Maryland and now owned and occupied by Stephen T. Cooper.
