



The whole of the above Tract is an Interference of a Tract of 316<sup>ac</sup> 120<sup>rs</sup> and all<sup>ac</sup> surveyed on the above Warrant October 18<sup>th</sup> 1749 — and divided 6<sup>th</sup> May 1836 by Isaac Robinson D.S. Part **AB** Containing 238<sup>ac</sup> 39<sup>rs</sup> & all<sup>ac</sup> now owned by Michael Harbold, in Reading Township, is at this date yet Unpatented — Part **C** Containing 78<sup>ac</sup> 81<sup>rs</sup> & all<sup>ac</sup> now owned by Abraham Cronister in Reading Town<sup>sh</sup>. I do not know whether it is patented or not — Witness my hand —
