



In pursuance of the several Acts of Assembly directing the recovery of the principal and interest due to the Commonwealth from persons holding Lands by Virtue of Locations or other office Titles issued from or under the Proprietary Government and for other purposes, I have this day located and surveyed Warrant dated 5th Oct. 1765 to Elisabeth Beavenaur in Trust for 100 acres on Lands formerly in Mt Pleasant now in Conowago Township Adams County, to include the imp^t made by her husband, & where they actually resided — and have found the interferences as represented in the enclosed Diagram — Witness my hand —

July 24th 1837.
