The lines of the above Survey appear to have been made in 1769. — 3 Warr^{ts} were afterwards granted to Daniel Reese, Samuel Reese & Thomas Grant. 10th Jan^y 1794 for land in Northumberland County, and which were laid on the above ground according to the yellow lines above laid down. — No improvement on the land.
