Report The above is precisely the same Land which was Surveyed in pursuance of a Warrant granted to George Schledesman for 100 ± dated the 11 day of May 1774 Now owned and occupied by Jacob Stambach part of this tract was Patented on the 6 March 1822 The name of Beat was never heard by any of the neighbours now living
