



Warrant granted 9<sup>th</sup> March 1753 to William Field for 50<sup>acs</sup> in Huntingdon Towne

In pursuance of the several Acts of Assembly directing the recovery of the Principal and Interest due to the Commonwealth from Persons holding Lands by virtue of Locations or other office Titles issued from or under the Proprietary Government & for other Purposes, I have this day located and surveyed Warrant granted 9<sup>th</sup> March 1753 to William Field for 50<sup>acs</sup> in Huntingdon Towne on Lands situate as aforesaid, and have found the Interferences as represented in the enclosed Diagram
