



Situate in Buffalo township, Union (late Berks) County Surveyed the 5<sup>th</sup> day of August 1833 by virtue of an order granted to John Armstrong dated the 3<sup>d</sup> day of April 1769 N<sup>o</sup> 1945 Containing two hundred & Seventy Nine acres & 87 ps. with the Usual Allowance of Six pr. Cent. & c.

Note The same tract of land was Surveyed the 13<sup>th</sup> day of June 1771 for David Davis in pursuance of his order dated the 3<sup>d</sup> day of April 1769 N<sup>o</sup> 1239 And now owned & occupied by John Hoy in right of the said David Davis.
